Kansas Legal Services staff will work to give legal advice regarding civil matters* such as:

- Family Law – Divorce, Child Custody, or Paternity
- Protection Orders
- Evictions and Landlord Tenant issues
- Small Claims
- Name Change
- Expungement
- Consumer and Credit Issues

*Advice is provided on non-criminal matters. KLS cannot assist with criminal/traffic matters.

1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Appointments preferred, walk-ins only as time allows and on a first come, first serve basis.

How do I schedule an appointment?

- Applications are required and are available at the Clerk of the District Court office.
- Return your completed application to the clerk and you will be contacted by Kansas Legal Services staff to schedule an appointment.
- When you arrive for your appointment, check in with the clerk and you will be directed to the self-help center.
