- All Filing Fees are 1% of the Salary K.S.A. 25-206
- All Report Fees are to the Kansas Public Disclosure Commission and the Secretary of State’s Office
- Republican & Democratic Petitions are 3% of the Party Registration in the district (October 2025 Certification)
- Independent Petitions are 4% of voters in the district except township offices (10 or 5%) (Independent candidates can ONLY file by petition. Upon filing a valid petition and paying the Report Fee (if required), the candidate’s name will be placed directly on the general ballot. An independent candidate must be registered as an unaffiliated voter
- Precinct Committee Members are not charged any fees. **Form must be notarized.**
