At the close of business day on the 13th day of October 2026, the books for registration of voters will close and will remain closed until the 4th day of November 2026.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or who will have attained the age of 18 at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Registration is open until the close of business on the 21st day before the election.

When a voter has been registered according to law, the voter shall remain registered until the voter changes name by marriage, divorce or other legal proceeding or changes residence. The voter may reregister in person, by mail or other delivery when registration is open.

Application forms shall be provided by the county election officer or the Secretary of State upon request. The application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury. Voters may also register to vote online at www.voteks.gov.
