



Measles Checklist Child Care

Before a Case Occurs

- Know measles signs and symptoms.
- Recommend anyone caring for children make sure they have received MMR vaccine or are considered immune to measles.
- Let families and child care staff know that if they have not received MMR vaccine, they may need to stay away from childcare for 21 days each time an exposure to measles occurs.

If an Enrolled Child or Staff Gets Measles

- Report suspected measles case(s) to KDHE (877-427-7317).
- Prepare to give contact and vaccine information for enrolled children and staff members in attendance while the person(s) had measles and were in attendance.
- Prepare to give contact information for visitors, volunteers, and other persons, who were at the child care facility while the person(s) had measles and were in attendance.
- Follow KDHE guidelines for exposed students and staff according to immunization/immunity status. More information on measles can be found on the [KDHE Measles Page](#).
